## Parents' Bill of Rights LA.RS. 17:406.9

As a parent, guardian, or caregiver of a student enrolled at Travis Hill NOLA Schools, you are an essential partner in your child's education. While we operate in a structured and secure environment, we are committed to fostering strong communication, trust, and collaboration with families.

## Your Rights as a Parent

- Educational Access and Support
  - Be informed of your child's educational progress, needs, and achievements.
  - Know what academic programs, courses, and services are available to your child.
  - Request academic records, report cards, transcripts, IEP/504 documentation (if applicable).
- Communication and Engagement
  - Receive regular updates about your child's progress, behavior, and attendance.
  - Schedule phone class, virtual meetings, or in-person conferences with staff.
  - Be notified of significant changes in your child's educational placement, schedule, or services.
- Special Education Rights
  - If your child has an exceptionality, you have the right to participate in all meetings related to your child's Individualized Education Plan (IEP) or 504 Plan.
  - Receive prior written notice and give informed consent regarding assessments, services, or educational decisions.
- Safe and Respectful Learning Environment
  - Expect that your child will be treated with dignity and respect by all school staff.
  - Be assured that the learning environment is safe, structured, and focused on positive growth and development.
  - Report concerns or complaints related to your child's education and have them addressed appropriately and promptly
- Participation in Planning
  - Be part of the reentry planning process for your child's transition back into the community and/or traditional school setting.

- Receiver support and resources that will help your child reintegrate successfully into their home school or workforce pathway.
- Confidentiality and Privacy
  - Expect that your child's educational information will be kept confidential and shared only with authorized personnel in accordance with FERPA and applicable laws.
- Language Access
  - Request and receive communication in your preferred language, including translated materials and interpretation services, whenever possible.
